

Dr. John Hugh Gillis Regional High School Criteria for Grade 12 Study Period and Consent.

Some grade 12 students on track to graduate, may have the option of having one study period each semester with parent permission and school approval.

Criteria for grade 12 study period:

1. Student must be able to meet all graduation course and/or program requirements with remaining courses, including, but, not exclusive to:
Course Requirement Examples: English, Mathematics, Global, Canadian Studies, etc.
Program Requirement Examples: Options & Opportunities, International Baccalaureate, French Immersion, Gaelic, etc.
2. Student may choose one study block per semester, with no other adjustment to current schedule.
3. Student must have signed parent permission and be approved by Guidance and Administration for any changes to occur and/or to leave school grounds during this time.
4. Student must sign out as per school policy or go to designated learning space in the building (Cafeteria). Students must be on time for their next scheduled class.
